Initially receiving a mixed critical reception, including much condemnation for its frank depiction of adultery, the novel has gone on to be recognized as both a classic piece of fiction and a groundbreaking work of women's realism. The poignant portrayal of the protagonist attempting to determine her true feminine identity makes this one of the first novels willing to openly confront women's issues, to make clear that traditional roles could be limiting and to legitimize an emotional life that transcended society's boundaries. With an eye-catching new cover, and professionally typeset manuscript, this edition of *The Awakening* is both modern and readable.
