Nevertheless, some international treaties have unified particular areas of substantive and conflicts law with respect to the participating states.

Principles Of Conflict Of Laws

Exclusion of conflict of laws principles clarifies that the parties intend that the governing law expressly indicated in the contract is to apply. The phrase “without regard to conflict of law principles” may be glossed over by a contracting party. Although, however cursory this phrase may appear to be, it is an important inclusion in a contract to avoid the imposition of the laws of another jurisdiction despite the intention of the contracting parties.

The primacy of European Union law (sometimes referred to as supremacy) is an EU law principle that when there is conflict between European law and the law of its member states, European law prevails, and the norms of national law are set aside. The principle was developed by the European Court of Justice, which interpreted that norms of European law take precedence over any norms of national
